

Occupational Health & Safety Management Systems

An Occupational Health and Safety Management System (OHSMS) is a tool used to reduce and control areas of risk and apply controls to improve its performance. OHSMS promotes a safe and healthy working environment by providing a framework that allows your organization to consistently identify and control those risks and measure performance.

Participants of these courses will receive training and direction from industry specific professionals with many years experience within Occupational Health and Safety. Along with industry related discussions, OHSAS courses like other courses offered by CMSI include in-class exercises and discussions.

Note: All auditor courses include written examination upon completion of course to validate student competency. Exams are 30 minutes to 2 hours in duration.

Understanding OHSAS 18001:2007

This one (1) day course takes a look into the best practices for occupational health and safety (OHSAS). This course will help participants acquire an understanding of the basics for OHSAS, system documentation and the process approach.

OHSAS 18001:2007 Internal Occupational Health and Safety Auditor

This three (3) day course is directed towards internal auditors, consultants and Environmental and Quality managers looking to implement OHSAS. This course provides a working comprehension of planning and conducting an internal audit of an occupational health and safety management system. Participants will acquire the tools necessary to categorize and record nonconformances.

OHSAS 18001:2007 Lead Occupational Health and Safety Auditor

Participants of this advanced four (4) day course will acquire a working comprehension of checking and corrective action processes, on-site verification techniques, measurement of efficiency and effectiveness of a process and categorizing and recording nonconformances. The course also addresses the principles of international and national legislation, risk assessment and policy development.
